Tornadoes KCA is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the wellbeing of all its members.

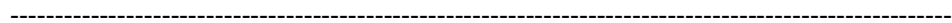
The club believes that it is important that members, coaches, volunteers and parents associated with the club should, at all times, show respect and understanding for the safety and welfare of others.

Therefore, members are encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or issues that they may have about any aspect of the club with the committee.

As a member of **Tornadoes KCA** you are expected to abide by the following codes of conduct:

- All members must play within the rules and respect officials and their decisions. Swearing and arguing will not be tolerated. Any fines incurred by a member must be paid before the next match.
- All members must respect opponents.
- All members must respect their own team members.
- Members should keep to agreed timings for training and competitions or inform their coach or team manager if they are going to be late or cannot attend.
- All members are expected to notify their team manager by the **Wednesday** to confirm their availability for the team fixture on the following Sunday.
- Members must wear suitable kit for training sessions -T shirt, shorts/skort, trainers and jogging bottoms. For matches – team shirts are provided by the Club, the members’ own black shorts (boys), black skorts (girls) and appropriate trainers.
- Members must pay any fees for training or matches promptly.
- Members when playing or refereeing must not chew gum, have long fingernails or wear jewellery (unless taped). Long hair must be tied back.
- Members are not allowed to smoke on Club premises or whilst representing the club at competitions.
- Members are not allowed to consume alcohol or drugs of any kind on the club premises or whilst representing the Club.
- Members are expected to respect the property at the training and match venues and clear up their own litter. The member who is responsible must pay for any breakages.
- Members are expected to help move the equipment safely at training sessions. Junior members must be supervised.
